Watercolor paper (cold press 140lb weight / 300 gsm)

Fine liner waterproof black pen (for example, Micron)

Mixed media coloring supplies (colored pencils, cray-pas / water-soluble pastels, or any other favorites you have)

Watercolor brushes (round #1 and round #4)

Watercolor paints - colors used by Sarah in the course are white (titanium white), yellow ochre, red (alizarin crimson), burgandy (Perylene maroon), dark blue-gray (Payne's gray), violet (Perylene violet), olive green (chromium oxide), red-brown (burnt Sienna), brown (Vandyke brown), cobalt blue (optional)

NOTE from Sarah on supplies: Below is a list of my favorites with links. They are not ALL required in any way, and I like to encourage my attendees to try and do what they can with what they have. Color Mixing Recipes for the course:

Flower Petals:

BUFF: 90% White + 10% Yellow Ochre

BLUSH: 50% White + 30% Yellow Ochre + 20% Alizarin Crimson

PURPLE MAUVE: Payne's Grey + Alizarin Crimson + Titanium White (because it's a

gradient, the percentage vary)

Alternative pretty colors:

MOODY MAUVE: 5% Payne's Gray 45% Cobalt Blue Hue + 50% Alizarin Crimson

DUSKY PINK: 44% White + 1% Payne's Gray + 55% Alizarin Crimson

LAVENDER: 10% White + 5% Yellow Ochre + 45% Payne's Gray + 40% Alizarin Crimson

Leaves:

OLIVE GREEN: 40% Oxide of Chromium + 60% Burnt Sienna

Alternatives to Mix if you don't have a Pure Professional Tube color listed above:

An alternative to Oxide of Chromium: 70% Sap Green + 30 % Ultramarine Blue

An alternative to **Perylene Violet**: 60% Alizarin Crimson + 40% Payne's Gray

An alternative to **Perylene Maroon**: 30% Burnt Sienna + 60% Alizarin Crimson + 1%

Ivory Black

An alternative to **Vandyke Brown**: Burnt Sienna + Ivory Black
